<u>The Peer Project | Youth Assisting Youth (YAY)</u> is a non-profit charitable organization that matches at-risk and newcomer children ages 6-15 with fully trained and dedicated volunteer youth mentors ages 16-29. Operating since 1976, The Peer Project has helped over 30,000 newcomer and at-risk kids. There are over 600 youth supported by the organization, and over 400 more kids on a wait list. The organization operates with a 98% success rate for keeping kids in school and out of the criminal justice system.

# **Mentoring Programs**

#### **ONE-TO-ONE PEER MENTORING**

Youth mentors age 16-29 act as positive role models to help at-risk and newcomer kids age 6-15 reach their full potential.

#### **GIRLS EMPOWERMENT**

Girls (mainly newcomer girls) receive mentoring over 10 weeks based on their needs, ranging from support for emotional wellbeing to self-defence.

#### CLICKS&STONES-CYBERBULLYING

An educator (and mother of a cyberbullied child) goes to classrooms of grade 7 and 8's to educate and fight cyber bullying.

#### **GROUP MENTORING**

Ongoing, structured activities and events, to support our "mentor matches", as well as the youth on the wait list.

#### YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH TRAINING

Mentors receive in-depth training on common youth mental health issues, designed to help them effectively mentor youth mentees coping with a diagnosis.

#### YOUTH LEARNING DISABILITIES TRAINING

Mentors receive in-depth training on youth learning disabilities; help them understand their mentee's unique way of learning in order to better mentor them.





# Why Youth Mentoring Works

Since 1976, Peer Project is doing their part to address this major health issue by helping the kids who are often too challenging for many other community agencies.

We've seen first-hand how mentoring can be life changing and help youth overcome mental health and life challenges.



- Mentored youth earn \$315,000 more income over their lifetime, on average.
- 45% of mentored youth are enrolled in higher education, compared to 29% of unmentored peers.
- Research shows an \$18 return per \$1 invested in youth mentoring; with a \$23 return for the least economically advantaged youth.
